INSCRIPTION AND PAYMENT

• Level test: it's obligatory and you have to do it before starting the course, unless you are a beginner.

• Enrolment and payment:

- Enrollment fees: 30€ (it includes the enrollment, level test, certificate and additional materials). It doesn't include books.
- Before starting the course you must pay the entire period in which you want to sign-up. You can pay in cash ($50 \in$ max.), with credit or debit card or by bank transfer.
- If you pay by weeks and months and want to continue studying you must pay your course before the last day of your current enrolment.
- If your last day not coincides with the last day of the academic course and you want to finish it, you need to pay before your last day of your current enrolment.
- If you need a certificate of enrolment to apply for a visa, we give you a document with extra information.
- Reserving a place: The reservation for your course and timetable chosen is valid for one week. (If after this week

the class is full you would still have your place booked but in a different time).

• A trial class: You need to pay 15 euros per trial class. If you decide to continue studying you need to pay the outstanding amount after the trial class and the 15 euros will be deduced from the total amount. If you don't sign-up after the trial class or if you decide to continue studying, but you do not pay the same day of the trial class, the school does not refund you the 15 euros.

Cancellation, resignation or enrollment change*:

- If you cancel the course at least 15 working days before the beginning of the course, the school refunds you the full amount of the course LESS 50 EUR for cancellation fees.
- If you cancel the course within the 15-working day term before the beginning of the course, the school refunds you the full amount of the course LESS 100 EUR for cancellation fees (8h and 4h/week courses) or 150 EUR for cancellation fees (20h, 18h, 16h, 14h, 12h and 10h/week).
- If you have enrolled in several consecutive courses (without a certificate of enrolment to apply for a visa) the same cancellation fees apply for each future course you cancel.
- If you cancel the course after it has already started, the school does not refund you and it is not permitted to pass it on another person or postpone it. If you want to postpone the date of the beginning of your course or to bring forward the end, you would need to make a written request and renounce to the rest of the course without any refund from the school.
- If you want to study less hours per week than the ones you have paid for, you would need to make a written request and renounce to the outstanding hours without the possibility of postponing them or getting any refund.
- If you want to study more hours per week than the ones you had paid for, you have to pay the equivalent of this new course.

*If you have requested a certificate of enrolment, please consult the extra information given to you for enrolling.

ORGANIZATION

- **Beginning of the courses:** Most of the students sign-up at the beginning of the course, but you may also sign-up for a course that has already started. First you have to do the level test. A new course (Basic 1) may start at the beginning of every month provided that there is a minimum of 5 persons.
- **Number of students in the class:** Minimum 5, Maximum 15. If a group ends up with less than 5 students, the school may cancel it and transfer the students to another group or refund the corresponding amount. If a group has been studying for

more than 2 months with less than 5 students, the school does not refund the proportional amount corresponding to the third month.

• **Textbooks:** textbook <u>is obligatory</u> in order to attend the class. You can buy your books at school. We do not provide copies of the books. If you are enrolled in a course for less than one month, subject to availability, you can rent them from the school leaving a deposit of 25 EUR per book, which will be given back to you when you return the books in the same conditions. If you return the books two weeks later than the end of your course, the school does not refund you the deposit.

• Timetable changes:

- you can change the timetable of your course once only if there is <u>another timetable option in the same level and type</u> of course (according to the availability).
- In case there is no other timetable option or there is no availability or the available timetable doesn't suit you, the school does not refund you or postpone the course.
- Level changes. If you want to change your level during the course, your teacher has to confirm it first and you need to pass a specific exam to enter a higher level.
- Holidays. Holidays are those officially established by the regional calendar, therefore are included in the prices. You can't catch up the classes missed during holiday period, except for the weekly price. Holiday periods are already excluded from the prices.

Absences:

- Attendance is taken daily. If you need a certificate of attendance it will state your actual attendance.
- If you miss the class for any personal reason the school does not refund or reschedule the missed class.
- If you miss 3 consecutive weeks, your level will need to be revised and it will probably change.
- Exams: All courses have a final exam. There is an official date and an extraordinary date one week before. You can't do the exam after the official date. You have to do the final exam to obtain the diploma. Admission in the next level depends on your final mark. There is a mid-way exam during the 3-month courses. If you want to take the final exam you need to pay till the end of the course.
- Certificates: To obtain the certificate of your course you have to pass the final exam at the official date. If you do not take it on this date, you will receive a certificate of attendance without your final mark. The school will send your certificate by email some weeks later after the final exam.

• If you study several consecutive courses:

- The school does not guarantee the same timetable for each trimester of all your courses. You can reserve the timetable for your next trimester before ending your current course.
- Admission in the following level depends on your final exam.
- If you want to sign-up for several consecutive trimesters and you already have an advanced level, the school does not guarantee all the levels of the courses you have signed up for.
